FEES AND CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION 2026-27

Admission to Austin Friars

Austin Friars is an independent co-educational day School, which sets out to admit pupils who are likely to benefit from the all round education which it provides, based on its Augustinian principles. The School accepts boys and girls of all denominations and faiths, offering education to children from the age of three to eighteen.

Registration and School Fees

For Pre-School entry, a combined registration fee and deposit of £250 secures the reserved sessions. This is refunded when a child starts with us. It is non-refundable in the event that your child does not take up their reserved place.

At all other entry points, a registration fee of £75 (non-refundable) is charged and this fee is not part of the tuition fees. A deposit of £250.00 is payable upon acceptance of a place and signature of the School's Contract.

School Fees

School fees for tuition are payable in advance on or before the first day of term. Incidental expenses such as specific text books, field trips, out-of-school activities, public examinations, school transport and personal expenses are

chargeable in arrears and are payable on or before the first day of the following term.

A reduction of 5% is made against tuition fees (excluding lunches and Personal Accident Insurance) in respect of the second or more siblings who are simultaneously in the School (excluding Pre-School).

Fees are normally reviewed annually in the Lent Term, to take effect from the start of the next academic year. The Board of Trustees reserves the right to adjust fees at any time during the academic year, for which one term's advance notice will normally be given.

Personal Accident Insurance, arranged by the School, is also provided for all pupils, the cost of which is included within the standard fees below.

Payment of School Fees

Payment of accounts for pupils' fees and expenses may be made:

- By Direct Debit, payable monthly in 10 equal instalments on 20th of the month commencing in July prior to the start of the academic year and ending the following April. This is the School's preferred option.
- By Direct Debit, payable termly on the first day of the school term.
- By cheque, payable to 'Austin Friars' on or before the first day of a school term.

Interest will be charged at 5% over the bank base rate on overdue accounts.

The School reserves the right to exclude a pupil from school in the event of failure to pay pupil accounts promptly.

A full term's notice must be given in the event of a removal of a pupil from the School. In default, fees for both the current term and the full term in respect of which notice should have been given, must be paid in lieu of notice.

The School reserves the right to suspend or exclude a pupil at any time. In such cases no claim for repayment of fees will be admitted. Under no circumstances will any allowance be made against fees due in the event of occasional absences of a pupil from school during term time.

Life membership of the Austin Friars Association (AFA) is payable at the rate of £10.00 per term during the child's attendance in Senior School.

Termly fees are calculated on an annual fee divided by three, to create three equal termly payments. The lengths of terms vary in length and the amount of face-to-face teaching will depend on the stage of education a pupil is at. These factors are taken into account when calculating the annual and thus termly fees.
